DID YOU KNOW THAT:

- 1. The settlement made here in 1788 by the society of the "Universal Friends" was the first pioneer movement in N.Y. state west of Seneca Lake?
- 2. City Hill Cemetery established in 1788 and is the oldest in the then known "Genesee Country
- 3. The first store in Torrey was owned by Elephalet Norris in 1792?
- 4. The road from Dresden to Penn Yan was once a plank road and part of a stage coach route at Leggs Corners which stood an Inn where coach passengers ate and some spent the night. A toll gate was west of the Pulver place and a 3¢ toll was collected. This building was removed in 1911.
- 5. Dresden was started about 1820 and was existing when Yates Co. was formed in 1823. Dresden was incorporated in July 1867 with Luther Harris as "President".
- 6. Population of Torrey in 1855 was 1320.
- 7. In 1909 the property tax was \$3.80 per thousand.
- 8. 1876-77 N.Y. Central R.R. built through Torrey (Fall Brook).
- 9. The first funeral procession made up of of automobiles in this town was in 1914.
- 10. Dresden was lighted by electricity in Feb. 1925?
