From the Desk of Town Supervisor (*Pat Flynn*):

- Application for Water District 1 (the Northeast area of the Town) submitted to the NYS Controller's Office has been approved
- Town of Torrey filed State Environmental Quality Review Act (**SEQRA**) as lead agency for Water District 1 stating there is non-significant environmental impact for Water District 1
- The Town of Torrey on November 13, 2018 approved a contract for Timothy McGill, Bond Counsel, for Water District 1
- The Town of Torrey on December 12, 2018 approved and signed a contract with **CPL** engineering team for engineering services for the design and construction of water mains for Water District 1
- On December 19, 2018 received letter from Tom DiNapoli, State Comptroller, stating the Town of Torrey received a grant of \$684,000 and a loan of \$892,000 from USDA for Water District 1
- Actual construction of Water District 1 has yet to be put out to bid

From the Desk of the Town Board:

- The Town Board meets the second Tuesday of the month at 7:30pm
- Formally approved the establishment of Town of Torrey Water District 1
- Finalizing a contract with the Town of Benton to supply water to Town of Torrey Water District 1 (WD1)
- Continues to work on a contract with the Village of Dresden to supply water to Town of Torrey Water District 2 (WD2)

- The Town Assessor is doing a required revaluation of all properties in the Town. The new assessments will be effective January 1, 2020.
Grievance Day is Thursday, May 30, 2019.

From the Desk of Town Clerk (*Betty Daggett*):

- Town Office is open Monday through Thursday from 9:00am - 4:00pm. Call 315-536- 6376
- Fee collection such as building permits, fines & fees issued by Code Office
- Licenses : marriage, hunting, fishing, dog & birth/death certificates (If you love your dog(s), please license them. Licensing helps with Identification of lost dogs and provides protection for the community. It is also NYS Ag & Market law- **ALL** dogs harbored in the Town of Torrey must be licensed yearly at the Town Clerk office).
- Those interested in a position as a recreation leader, counselor, or lifeguard for the Summer Recreation program should check with the Town Clerk

From the Desk of Town Highway Superintendent (*Tim Chambers*):

- Off hours emergency callout number: 315-729-2706
- With Town Board approval the Highway Department is purchasing mower head and mounting bracket for the excavator to mow deep ditches and behind guide rails
- Consolidated Local and Highway Improvement Projects (CHIPs) funds (approximately \$65,000) will be used to pave, stone, or oil several roads throughout the Town
- Torrey Cleanup Days will be held July 27th and 28th (see more details under **Upcoming Community Events**)
- *Reminder according to NYS law:*
 - + throwing trash, garbage, rubbish, litter or refuse on Highways and adjacent lands is prohibited
 - + the town superintendent of highways shall sue for and

recover a penalty not to exceed \$100 from any person depositing ashes, snow, ice, stones, sticks, etc. upon a hwy or on grass or loose stones adjoining a town hwy

From the Desk of Town Code Enforcement Officer (*Dwight James*):

- Call the Town Office at 315-536-6376 (cell 315-730-3291) or email at torreycodes@gmail.com to inquire about Permits. When in doubt ask!
- Building permits are required for any electrical, plumbing, insulation, or structural work undertaken
- Construction or alteration of any accessory structure, addition or new construction requires a permit
- Reminder all short term rentals must be registered with the Town
- Year-to-Date there have been 39 permits issued and \$3585.00 permit fees collected as well as 25 short term rentals reviewed

From the Desk of Town Watershed Inspector (*Yates Cty Soil & Water*)

The Town's inspectors can be contacted at the Yates County Soil and Water Conservation Department 315- 536-5188.

In November of 2014, the Town of Torrey passed a local Wastewater Law effective January 1, 2015. Under the new law, any onsite wastewater treatment system within 200' of Seneca Lake or a DEC classified stream is required to be inspected every 5 years. The cost of the inspection is borne by the Town of

Torrey (unless this is a property transfer). However any pumping of the septic or repair is a cost to the homeowner. We are now in year 5 of these inspections.
